Wellness Event

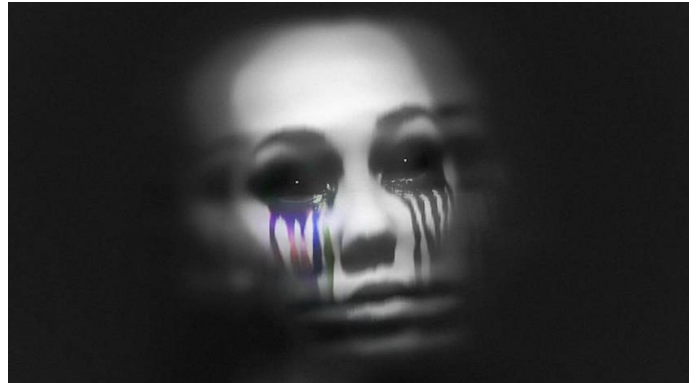
